IMPLEMENTATION OF SS 532 : 2024 – CODE OF PRACTICE FOR THE STORAGE OF FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS

The 4th edition of SS 532 : 2024 – Code of Practice for the storage of flammable liquids was officially launched by Enterprise Singapore on 18 Mar 2024. This standard provides an update on the previous edition of SS 532 : 2016 to reflect change in industry practices.

2. Please be informed that the standard shall be applicable to all building plans that are submitted to SCDF for approval from 01 December 2024. This grace period is given to the building industry to plan for any new building projects. Any proposed plans of fire safety works for new buildings / premises or alteration / alteration works to existing buildings / premises that are submitted to SCDF for approval on or after the effective date will be subjected to the new standard. Notwithstanding the above, SCDF has no objection to the immediate adoption of the revised standard.
